

2019 NPSA Recorder Summary Executive Council Meeting Victoria, British Columbia



- 2018 NPSA Meeting with 37 total papers submitted to American Journal of Surgery
 - Acceptance rate 90%
- Two topical review articles
- Presidential Address
- Special report paper based on Trauma/ACS Panel Session

- Multiple complaints and problems when AJS migrated to the EVISE platform. The journal is migrating back to the Editorial Manager platform sometime in November or December

- 2019 NPSA meeting will have 40 accepted abstracts for podium presentations, all of which are invited to submit a manuscript to AJS (including video presentations)
- Solicited two review articles to also be submitted through NPSA
 - review of complex cholecystitis by Marina Parapini
 - systematic review of liposarcoma by Antoine Bouchard-Fortier

- Submission deadline for all manuscripts and discussions is November 9th
- All authors and discussants received email invite from EVISE with a link to submit their manuscripts/discussions
- Two peer reviewers will be assigned for each submitted manuscript - the assigned discussant and one other NPSA member
- Plan for succession: Dr. Laszlo Kiraly has agreed to serve as recorder, and will co-manage the NPSA edition with me this year and then take over as Recorder for the 2020 meeting.
